The Northeast Tarrant County A&M Club uses the following guidelines for our 2019-20 Scholarship:

- We will award up to six individual \$1,000.00 scholarships to the Top Six qualified student applicants who attend a public or private high school in Keller, Southlake, Grapevine/Colleyville, or Northwest ISD, and reside in Northeast Tarrant County zip codes designated by Association of Former Students.
- We base the Award on the following criteria: Academic Performance, Character and Leadership Contributions (including extracurricular involvement and community and volunteer services), and responses to three Essay Questions. Also, an official High School Transcript is required.
- Note: The Award Selection Process may or may not include an interview for select candidates.
- We will submit the Scholarship Award payment directly to the Texas A&M Registrar for application to student's account upon receipt of recipient's official registration information from Texas A&M University.
- We ask our Scholarship Award Recipients to complete a brief, informal video for the Club to share at our Muster ceremony in 2020.
